# ABOUT THE ARTIST

Madhuri Bhaduri, born in 1958 in Pune, has been a significant presence in the global art scene for over four decades. A national-level Badminton and Squash player during her school and college years, Madhuri's talents extended beyond sports. She pursued a diploma in French from the Alliance Française de Pune and briefly explored Hotel Management, completing specialized courses in Baking and Housekeeping from FCI Pune.



In 1988, Madhuri graduated with a Master's degree in painting from SNDT Mumbai University, though her artistic journey began in the 1970s. Her first solo exhibition, held in Pune in 1986, was met with appreciation from notable figures such as the Late Maharani Gayatri Devi and the Late Jamshed Bhabha, giving her the confidence to pursue a professional art career.

While Madhuri's primary medium has always been oil painting, her artistic practice has evolved to include unique sculptures and murals crafted from scrap metal and recycled materials. To deepen her knowledge of the art market, she completed a short course in Finance and Art Market Studies from Sotheby's Institute of Art, London, in 2016.

Her illustrious career includes over 50 solo exhibitions and participation in more than 140 group shows in major art galleries worldwide, from New York to Delhi. Her works feature in over 400 prestigious collections globally, held by institutions and private connoisseurs alike.

Madhuri's contributions to the art world have been recognized with numerous accolades, including the Sarojini Naidu Award, the Times of India Femina Pune Art Award (2019-20), the Amrita Shergill Rashtriya Kala Puraskar from the National Institute of Fine Arts (NIFA) in New Delhi, and the Exceptional Woman of Excellence in Art award from the Women's Economic Forum (WEF) at The Hague. In 2018, she was honored with the Entrepreneur of the Year Award by the Bharat Nirman Foundation.

Madhuri is an active participant in the art community, serving as an adjudicator for art competitions, giving lectures, conducting workshops, and participating in art camps, residencies, and panel discussions. Her work has been extensively featured in globally recognized publications.

A committed philanthropist, Madhuri supports numerous charitable causes across India, continuing to inspire both through her art and her contributions to society.
